Hangang Story Gallery is the only exhibition hall centered around the theme of the Hangang River. Visitors can experience the Hangang River's history and cultural value in everyday life.

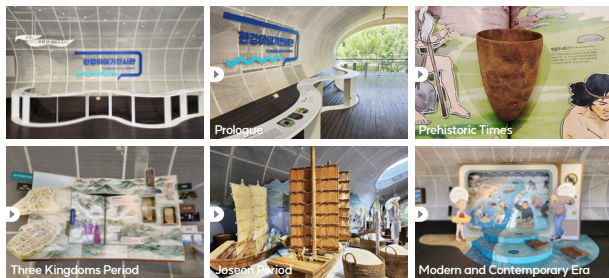

SPACE 1 HISTORY OF HANGANG

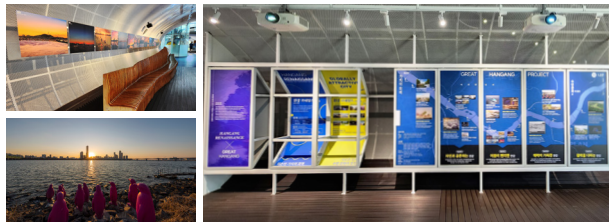
STORIES CLOSE TO OUR HEARTS, LONG YEARS WITH HANGANG RIVER

The Prologue section introduces various information about Hangang River, from its old name to bridges that cross the river and the Hangang Park. Follow the wavy panel and explore how the lives of people who had lived by Hangang River have changed from the prehistoric period to today. (Prologue > Prehistoric Times > Three Kingdoms Period > Joseon Period > Modern and Contemporary Era)



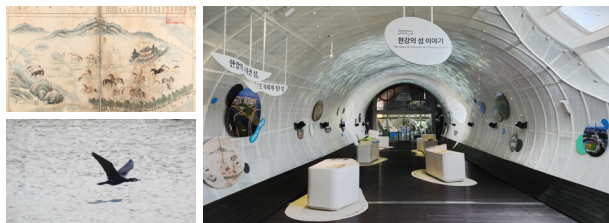
SPECIAL EXHIBITION "GREAT HANGANG PROJECT"

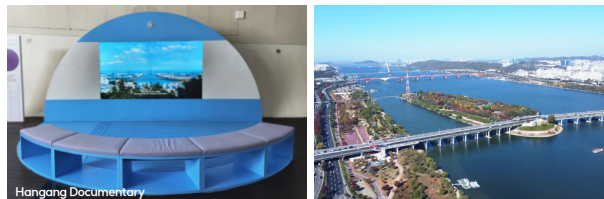

SPACE 2 CULTURE OF HANGANG

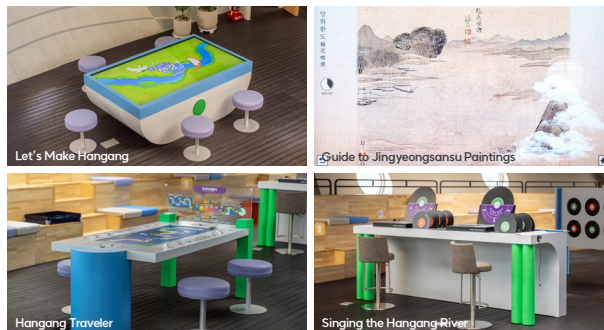
MEDIA HANGANG

Through three documentary videos on Hangang River's geographical features, history, and expert interviews, learn what makes this river so meaningful and valuable. (Hangang Documentary)



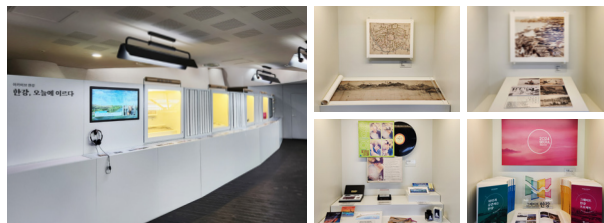
PLAY HANGANG
